

Local Coverage Determination (LCD) is a decision by a Medicare Administrative Contactor whether to cover a particular product, procedure, or service in its jurisdictional area in accordance with § 1862 (a)(1) of the Social Security Act. All wound care providers should be knowledgeable about Medicare coverage prior to providing products, procedures, or services to Medicare beneficiaries.

In cases where providers believe Medicare coverage will be denied on reasonable and necessary grounds under Medicare coverage policies, providers should have the patient sign an Advance Beneficiary Notice of Noncoverage (ABN).

This document is provided as a courtesy to assist you in locating the LCDs that are pertinent to your wound care business. Physicians and other qualified healthcare professionals are responsible for identifying, understanding, and complying with all applicable payer requirements. Smith & Nephew is not responsible for errors or changes to the Medicare Coverage Database.
